### Action: Provider Audit Submission Exception for Mary Lee's House

**Date:** Executive/Finance Committee Meeting, Thursday, February 9, 2023 **Recommended Action** 

Approve Mary Lee's House request to submit a "Review" instead of an "Audit" of their Annual Financial Statements ending December 31, 2022.

#### <u>Background</u>

• Board Policy 2.13.E states:

<u>Failure to Submit Audits or Reviews</u>. The approval of the Executive Committee of the Children's Board shall be required to continue payments under the Agreement to any provider who has not furnished the Children's Board with an acceptable audit or review report within 180 days after the close of the provider's fiscal year or before the end of the contract period in the case of newly funded agencies who lack prior audits or reviews as described in "Newly Funded Agencies Without Audits or Reviews" above.

- Mary Lee's house was funded beginning January 19, 2022.
- CBHC received a copy of the Mary Lee's House Audited Financial Statements dated December 31, 2020, on February 16, 2022.
- Executive Committee approved a "review" for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021.
- The Mary Lee's House Finance Committee is recommending a "review" for the December 31, 2022 financial statements because of the increased cost of a review and an audit.
